OUTLAWRY IN THE PHILIPPINES

Methods Pursued by Tagals to Terrorize Peaceful Natives.

WASHINGTON, March 18 .- The record's in the cases of thirty-four Filipino natives, charged with various offenses against military discipline in the Philippines, including murder, treason and other acts of violence, have been received at the war department. These records make plain the methods pursued by the insurgents to terrorize the native inhabitants of the islands, and show cases of atrocities committed upon the latter where they declined to comply with the demands and exactions of the so-called Filipino government.

In one case nine insurgent sympathizers, tuily armed, seized in the night a family or five persons and killed them with bolos. The motive for the murder was the punishment of the family for refusing to pay taxes in support of the insurgent government. The guilty natives were sentenced to hard labor for thirty years. In another case, under the orders of an insurgent lieutenant-colonel, a native was seized, bound and made to sit down while a soldier "held his head and with a knife cut his throat." The murderer was condemned to be hanged. Most of the other cases were the murder of innocent Filipinos by alleged soldiers and officers of the insurgent army, several of whom are described as notorious bandits and outlaws. The most atrocious, according to the records, is that of Eusebio Rojas, who was sentenced to be hanged, styling himself a lieutenant of infantry in the insurgent forces under the command of Alejandrino. 
