Wreckage Comes Ashore.

ASTORIA. Or., March 21.-Wreckage from a vessel is being washed upon Clatsop beach, near Geathart Park. This here. With it came some more cases of salmon that were a portion of the cargo of the British ship Ardnamurchan, which sailed from Vancouver, B. C., December 3rd last, and which has been reinsured. While the wreckage has not been identified, it is believed to be from that vessel. The wreckage is painted, a portion being the interior paneling of a vessel's cabin and a door that had been forcibly torn from it. The lock had been violently wrenched from the door, leaving some of the brass screws. The beach will be watched for more wreckage in order that the identity of the vessel may be positively established.
