

The Washington correspondent of the Corvallis Gazette pays the following deserved compliment to Senator McBride: "While there is rejoicing over the reappearance of Senator Mitchell there is really regret at the departure of Senator McBride, who has won the warm regard of the influential senators and proved himself a very capable and useful member of the upper house. Much that the senator has done for Oregon will never be known, and will never be appreciated at home. His attitude in several matters has not pleased the Oregonian, and most of the news the Oregon people get from the national capital comes to them colored by the state's only newspaper. The president's appreciation for Senator McBride's work in upholding and carrying out the policies of the administration is shown in the prompt and unsolicited appointment of the senator as commissioner of the St. Louis exposition, a position which carries a salary of \$5,000 a year, for three years."

She served Captains Lewis and Clark, the century ago explorers, as an interpreter, and gave them a vast amount of valuable and otherwise unobtainable information.

Mr. Dunn, Oregon's special correspondent, has as one of his duties a special chronology of the work and doings of Senator Simon. New Law On Weights and Measures.

The new state law relating to the standard weight of produce, provides that whenever wheat, rye, Indian corn, oats, barley, clover seed, buckwheat, dried apples, dried peaches, potatoes or pears shall be sold by the bushel, and no special arrangement as to the measure or weight thereof shall be made by the parties, the measure thereof shall be computed as follows:

- Sixty pounds for a bushel of wheat or clover seed.
Fifty-six pounds for a bushel of rye or Indian corn.
Thirty-two pounds for a bushel of oats.
Forty-six pounds for a bushel of barley.
Forty-two pounds for a bushel of buckwheat.
Thirty-eight pounds for a bushel of dried apples or peaches.
Sixty pounds for a bushel of potatoes.
Forty-five pounds for a bushel of apples or pears.

A sidewalk commencing at the northwest corner of block No. 7, and running easterly to the northeast corner of said block No. 7, and abutting on the northern boundary line of said block No. 7.

OCEAN AND RIVER SCHEDULE From Portland.

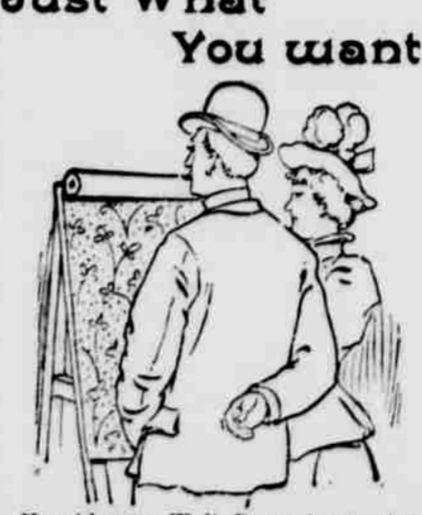
