

The Chronicle very heartily endorses every word of the following, which appeared in last week's Antelope Herald: "Wasco county will not forget her political debts, and when occasion offers itself there are two members of the recent legislative body who are going to find that they have many warm friends in this county. The last session of the legislature was a season that truly 'tried men's souls,' but not once were these two men found wanting. Threats could not move them, money could not buy them. Working shoulder to shoulder with Senator Williamson and Representative McGreer, they guarded closely the interests of Eastern Oregon and of their constituents in Wasco and their joint counties. On the fish-wheel question, the scalp-bounty law, the senatorial question and every other matter of importance, they could always be found with their people. Wasco county is not slow to recognize her friends, and among them she is glad to count the Hon. R. A. Emmitt, of Klamath, and Hon. Geo. H. Cattanch, of Grant.

Resubmission to the people of Maine of the prohibitory amendment to the constitution was defeated in the legislature of that state after a three hours' debate, by a vote of 84 to 34, with 20 paired and 13 absent and unpaired. While the local-option state of Massachusetts has one retail revenue license for every 567 of its population, according to the Topeka Journal, Maine, which is a prohibition state, has one retail liquor license for every 478 of its population, and the statement was made in debate that for the year ending June 30, 1900, over 1500 government liquor licenses were issued in Maine, or one for every 463 persons in the state.

It is laughable to see some of the Oregon democratic newspapers assuming respectability at the expense of Richard Croker, the tammany boss, says the Salem Statesman. Thinking it is popular to abuse Croker, there is nothing too mean for them to say about him, yet, as a matter of fact, the existence of Mr. Croker and his immense political machine has been the only possible hope of democratic success in the nation for many years. Possibly Richard did not do as much as he could have done to elect Mr. Bryan.

Mr. Scott, as soon as Senator Mitchell returned from Salem, after being elected senator, called on Mr. Mitchell at his rooms in the hotel and requested that the olive branch be allowed to sway peacefully above them, in recognition of Mitchell's victory. This is a chivalrous and graceful way to bury the hatchet, and may possibly mean a good deal in the future for Mr. Scott, politically, says the Portland Chronicle.

Mr. Cleveland's contention that "democracy is the prime requirement of the democratic party" would be much more intelligible if some satisfactory understanding could be reached as to just what constitutes democracy, pertinently remarks the San Francisco Post.

Taking the work of all the legislative bodies into account, there were about 10,000 new laws enacted during the past winter. In legislation everything goes except polygamy and the river and harbor bill.—Globe-Democrat.

By virtue of the order and direction of the Council of Dalles City, as by resolution heretofore adopted, notice is hereby given that the Council of Dalles City has determined to establish sidewalks and crosswalks for Tenth street in Gates Addition to Dalles City, and for Clay street, in Bluff Addition to Dalles City, as follows:

A sidewalk commencing at a point where the east line of Court street would intersect the northern boundary line of the school property of school District No. 12, of Wasco County, Oregon, said property being known as the academy grounds, if said line would be extended to said northern boundary line and running thence easterly to the northeast corner of said property of said school district and abutting on the northern line of said property.

A sidewalk commencing at the northwest corner of block No. 5 and running easterly to the northeast corner of said block and abutting on the northern boundary line of said block No. 5.

A crosswalk running straight across B street and joining on the west the sidewalk abutting on the northern boundary line of said block No. 5, and joining on the east a sidewalk abutting on the northern boundary line of block No. 6.

A sidewalk commencing at the northwest corner of said block No. 6, and running easterly to the northeast corner of said block and abutting on the northern boundary line of said block No. 6.

A crosswalk running straight across C street and joining on the west the sidewalk abutting on the northern boundary line of said block No. 6, and joining on the east a sidewalk abutting on the northern boundary line of block No. 7.

A sidewalk commencing at the northwest corner of block No. 7, and running easterly to the northeast corner of said block and abutting on the northern boundary line of said block No. 7.

A crosswalk running straight across D street and joining on the west the sidewalk abutting on the northern boundary line of said block No. 7, and joining on the east a sidewalk abutting on the northern boundary line of block No. 8.

A sidewalk commencing at the northwest corner of block No. 8 and running easterly 100 feet, and abutting on the northern boundary line of said block No. 8.

A crosswalk running straight across D street and joining on the west the sidewalk abutting on the northern boundary line of said block No. 8, and joining on the east a sidewalk abutting on the northern boundary line of block No. 9.

A sidewalk commencing at the northwest corner of block No. 9 and running easterly 100 feet, and abutting on the northern boundary line of said block No. 9.

A crosswalk running straight across E street and joining on the west the sidewalk abutting on the northern boundary line of said block No. 9, and joining on the east a sidewalk abutting on the northern boundary line of block No. 10.

A sidewalk commencing at the northwest corner of block No. 10 and running easterly 100 feet, and abutting on the northern boundary line of said block No. 10.

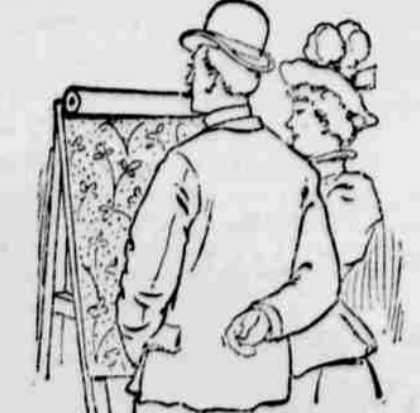
