

BRITISH SUBSIDIES.

The Philadelphia Press has disclosed the fact that the British government, while paying subsidies to British vessels for carrying the mails, is now trying to conceal the fact. A private letter from the secretary of the British postoffice department, written to a British shipowner, acknowledges that contracts for carrying the mails are not let to the lowest bidder, and are only given to British ships. Advertisements are purposely worded to include foreign bidders, but the secretary of the postoffice department acknowledges that that is a mere pretense and that such contracts are not given to foreign ships, no matter how low the bid may be.

A few years ago a German line bid for carrying the mails from England to the United States, and the bid was so much lower than that of any British line that the contract was actually given to the German line. 
