

MANILA, April 13.-General Mac-Arthur has forwarded to Washington a special report on saloons and the social evil in the Philippine islands. Information concerning the doings of Aguinaldo is withheld by the authorities. The wife and mother of Aguinaldo have been almost his only visitors during the past week. General MacArthur considers inopportune the suggestion made here that Aguinaldo visit the United States.

"If the complainants could be heard to assert here rights personal to themselves in the treaty invaded, and if the mules and horses involved in this cause are munitions of war, all of which is disputed by the defendants, it would become necessary to determine whether the United States intended by the declaration of the treaty of Washington, of May. 1871, to subvert the well-established principle of international law that the private citizens of a neutral nation can lawfully sell supplies to belligerents. The principle that neutral citizens may lawfully sell to belligerents has long been settled in this country by the highest judicial authorities."
