America he will be surprised to find that our growth, our contentment and our success as a nation, great in everything, has been due largely to our liberality in matters of religious worship. As for Mr. Kruger, he cannot expect that the world will be in love with his form of government and ready to take sides for its continuance, unless be advances a few steps in civilization and gives to the Catholics and to the Jews the right to worship God that he reserves to himself. Mr. Kruger has kept his government too closely confined in prejudice for it to be popular as a republic.


