> "No efforts has been made by the county officials to check the disease; no quarantine on diseased persons even was established. In each of the towns of Wallace, Sultan and Monroe there exist between 50 and 75 cases. Nothing is done to prevent the patients coming in contact with others. The epidemic is spreading rapidly, and something must be done at once. Every day or two some patient escapes from pesthouses at Warren and Irving.
