### Rev. Mr. Herron Suspended.

DES MOINES, Ia., May 1.—The Grinnell Association of Congregational churches, at a meeting held at Baxter, Ia., suspended Dr. George D. Herron from membership and recommended that the Grinnell Congregational church institute inquire into his fitness for ministerial duties.

The resolutions adopted make no mention of Dr. Herron's alleged heresies, referring simply to different charges made against him in court of record and which "the court deemed sufficiently grave to warrant granting Mrs. Herron a divorce."

The resolution preferring charges against Dr. Herron was unanimously adopted, no one speaking in his behalf.
