MAY GROW OUR OWN COFFEE

Superior Article Can Be Produced in Porto Rico, Hawaii and the Philippines—Large Consumption in America.

NEW YORK, May 6.—That all the coffee consumed in the United States can be grown in the islands which have been acquired since the outbreak of the Spanish war is the conclusion reached by the bureau of statistics of the treasury department at Washington, after a careful study of the coffee-producing capabilities of the new possessions.

The islands in which coffee can be successfully grown are Hawaii, Porto Rico and the Philippines. Porto Rican coffee, in the markets where it is well known, is regarded as the best in the world, and it is the conclusion of the bureau of statistics that when coffee plantations have been developed in the Philippines and Hawaii, all of the \$1,000,000 or more which the United States sends abroad every week for coffee can be expended among the inhabitants of our own islands. Porto Rican coffee has long commanded high prices in European markets, though it has been comparatively little known in the United States.

Developments of coffee culture in Hawaii during the last few years have been very satisfactory in the quality produced, and the prices realized. In the Philippines the product is of high grade.

The fact that the United States is by far the greatest coffee consuming country, and is steadily increasing her consumption, suggests that American capital and energy may turn their attention to the promising field now opened in the islands. American coffee importations during the nine months ending with March, 1901, amounted to 617,344,000 pounds, with a value of \$45,218,000, a sum nearly \$5,000,000 in excess of the value of the coffee imports of the same months of the preceding fiscal year, indicating that for the full fiscal year the total value of the coffee imported into the United States will be about \$60,000,000.

Finds Estate Worth \$200,000.

SEATTLE, May 6.—Josiah Collins, of Seattle, who was appointed administrator of the estate of Frederick Hutchinson, one of the pioneer miners of the Yukon, who died recently in Philadelphia, has discovered that he is in control of an estate worth \$200,000. When he opened Hutchinson's box in the safe deposit vault, expecting to find a moderate sum, he discovered sacks of gold nuggets and securities valued at nearly the sum named. This fortune will go to Herbert Hutchinson, of Philadelphia, a brother of the dead Klondike miner, and two sisters, who live in England.

CANAL ROUTE SURVEYED

The Work is Complete and the Men Are Returning Home.

WASHINGTON, May 6.—

The engineers who have been making a survey for a canal in Nicaragua have finished their work and the last party will leave Greytown for home on the steamer that sails the 11th of May. A few people will be left to pay the bills and look after the property of the government that will be stored there, but the survey is practically done and a route has been selected and staked out in detail. The rough estimate of the cost of constructing a canal along this line is \$210,000,000, but that is subject to a correction when the final report of the engineers is received.

The cost of a canal across the isthmus of Panama with five locks is estimated to be \$140,000,000, in addition to what has already been spent. The French company will demand anywhere from \$90,000,000 to \$125,000,000 for their franchise, property and the works they have already done, but would probably settle for \$75,000,000. A canal on a sea level according to the engineers would cost \$250,000,000 in round numbers, with one lock at the Panama end in order to protect it from the remarkably high tides that prevail there varying from twenty-five to thirty feet twice a day. In the opinion of all engineers a sea level canal across the isthmus of Panama is the most desirable, although it would be the most expensive. The greatest objection to it is the length of time required for its construction, which is estimated at twenty years. It is believed that with the work already done a canal with locks across Panama could be completed in six or seven years. Ten years is the time fixed for the Nicaragua route. The reason that the sea level canal at Panama would take so long a time is that the space is limited and it would be possible to work only a small number of men and excavators. The heavy digging is all at the water sheds, within the limits of a few miles.

When the engineers return from Nicaragua the commission will complete its final report to be submitted to congress in December.

President at El Paso.

EL PASO, Tex., May 6.—The American and Mexican flags were intertwined in the decoration of the plaza, where the official greeting of President McKinley and cabinet took place this morning. The presence on the stand of General Hernandez, the personal representative of President Diaz, gave international significance to the event. There were thousands of Mexicans in the vast concourse of people and their enthusiasm was almost as wild as that of the Americans.

The president's speech was especially noticeable on account of his injunction to the people not to be alarmed about imperialism. There was, he said, no imperialism except the imperial power of the sovereign people of the United States. At noon the presidential party resumed its journey westward.
