### STORY A FALSEHOOD

President Will Not Refuse to Meet Kruger—On the Other Hand, He Will Be Glad to Receive the Former Boer President at the White House.

NEW YORK, May 7.—The denial in positive terms in official circles that the president stated to anybody claiming to represent "Oom Paul" Kruger that he would not receive him at the White House was made in a way, says a special to the Tribune from Washington, which seems to indicate that the president has been communicated with on this subject, since he left Washington, and desired it to become known that he is being misrepresented in this matter. In point of fact, various persons authorized to speak for the president declare that on more than one occasion when the subject has been referred to in his presence the president has said that he would be glad to receive Mr. Kruger on the same terms and with the same hospitality as he receives other distinguished foreigners.

This could be done without compromising the government in any way. It is pointed out that when the Boer envoys were in Washington a year ago they were treated with marked courtesy and consideration by the president and every member of his cabinet with whom they came in contact. It is further pointed out that if former President Kruger comes here he will appear in a strictly private capacity, not being invested even with the official character with which the Boer envoys were clothed, and that therefore the president would have no possible reason for refusing to meet him.

#### Banker Scores Ministers.

NEW YORK, May 7.—Banker Warner Vannorden told the Presbyterian Union at its meeting last night that ministers took too long vacation during the summer. Some of the most prominent ministers in the city were present. Mr. Vannorden in discussing the vacation of ministers, said:

"It has become nothing less than a scandal that so many ministers leave their churches from three to four months of the year. Merchants and bankers do not get any such vacations. We are not able to take them. There 1,000,000 people living in the tenements, and they cannot go away for the summer. If we are going to bring the gospel to the people, it is not a good thing for the leader in the work to shirk."

#### Boom for Hanna.

WASHINGTON, May 7.—In a cabled interview from London, Perry S. Heath, secretary of the Republican National Committee, takes occasion to boom Hanna for the Presidency, saying, he would be the easiest man to nominate and the easiest man to elect in 1904." Hanna himself says it all stuff and nonsense, and that he punctured a boom started for him by Senator Scott, of West Virginia. At the same time it is no doubt pleasing to Hanna to be thus mentioned for the Presidency, but he is shrewd enough politician to understand that he would not be an ideal candidate.

#### Saloon Smashers' Party.

TOPEKA, Kas., May 7.—A movement is on foot here to organize a new political party which shall champion the cause of the saloon smashers. Those agitating the organization are mostly followers of Mrs. Nation and the party will be known as the "Nation party." Mrs. J. P. White is at the head of the movement. She says that neither of the old parties will give the aid expected in the suppression of the saloon traffic.

#### Claims Aggregating \$5,000,000.

NEW YORK, May 7.—Claims aggregating \$5,000,000 will be filed on behalf of surviving seamen of the battleship Maine, and by the next of kin of those seamen whose lost their lives in Havana harbor on the evening of February 15, 1898, according to Attorney Harwood, of the firm of Butler & Harwood, of this city.

"While I have no doubt," said Mr. Harwood last night, "that the course taken by our clients will surprise the Court of Claims, my faith in the equity of the cause is unshaken. While the Maine was not mentioned in the treaty between this country and Spain, it was expressly provided that the United States and Spain mutually relinquish all claims for indemnity, national and individual, of every kind, or of its citizens or subjects, against the other government that may have arisen since the beginning of the late insurrection in Cuba. The United States will adjudicate and settle the claims of its citizens against Spain.

"The only thing we have to prove is that prior to the ratification of the treaty containing this article our citizens had valid claims against the Spanish crown for injuries suffered in Havana harbor on the night of February 15."

#### Election in Baltimore.

BALTIMORE, May 7.—The municipal election in this city today, the first one of importance held under the new ballot law, resulted in a sweeping victory for the republicans. They carried 18 out of the 24 wards, electing eighteen members to the first branch city council and all three candidates for the second branch. Only about 65 per cent of the entire registered vote was polled and the colored vote was very light. Democrats attribute their defeat to factional differences, the friends of Mayor Hayes, who met with defeat in the primaries, being arrayed against the followers of Freeman Basin. The majorities were greatly reduced in the six wards carried by the democrats.

#### She Murdered Her Husband.

POUGHKEEPSIE, N. Y., May 7.—An interesting point has been raised here under the pension laws. Lizzie Halladay, an inmate of the Mattewan State Hospital for the Criminal Insane, is an applicant for a pension. Her husband was a soldier and was murdered by her at her home near Warwick, Orange county, N. Y., more than three years ago. He had been missing for several

days when it was discovered that she had killed him and hidden his body under a pig pen. She was taken to the asylum at Mattewan a raving maniac, and now claims the pension of a soldier's widow, notwithstanding the fact that she became a widow by murdering her husband. Colonel W. L. Delacy, a local pension attorney, says that under the law or June 27, 1890, he is entitled to her pension, as it excludes only the widows of those who commit suicide.

#### After Red Star Line.

LONDON, May 7.—Simultaneously with today's meeting of the Leyland Line shareholders to vote upon the agreement with J. Pierpont Morgan, comes a reiteration of the statement that the Morgans are about to acquire the Red Star line as well as the Atlantic Transport line.

The Leyland Line shareholders unanimously confirmed the Morgan-Eilerman agreement. The American Line officials here, however, deny the report that Mr. Morgan has acquired the Red Star Line.

NEW YORK, May 7.—James A. Wright, second vice-president of the International Navigation Company, was shown the dispatch of the Associated Press from London referring to the reiterated report that Mr. Morgan was about to acquire the Red Star Line. He said:

"I have nothing to say. The statement has been contradicted before. I know nothing about it."

#### Cubans Will Accept Platt Amendment.

HAVANA, May 7.—The special commission of the Cuban Constitutional convention, which returned here from Washington, May 5th, will not make any recommendations to the convention. Although the majority of the commissioners are in favor of accepting the Platt amendment, the report will only cover the facts of the conference at Washington. The convention will hold a secret session this afternoon. The radical element admits the convention will accept the amendment.
