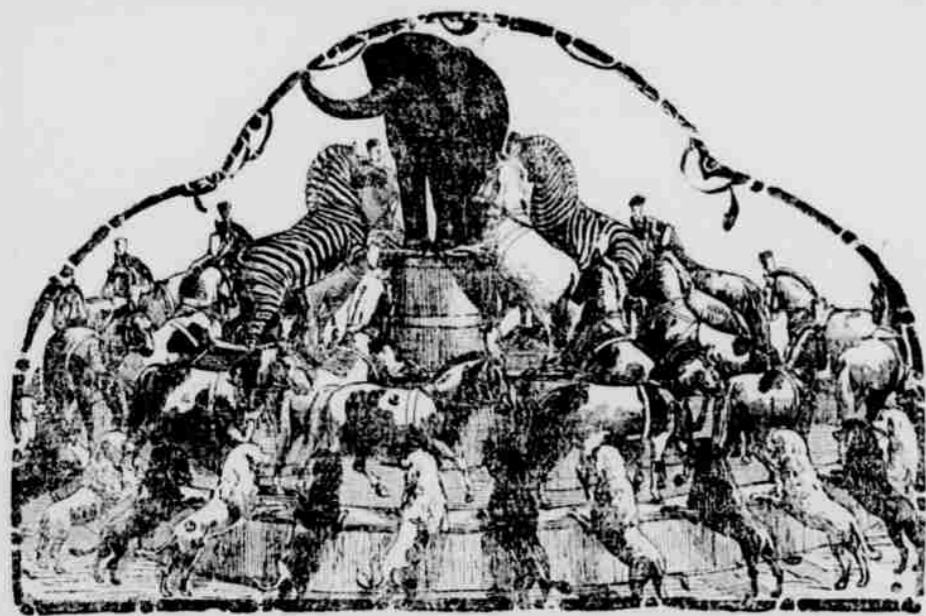

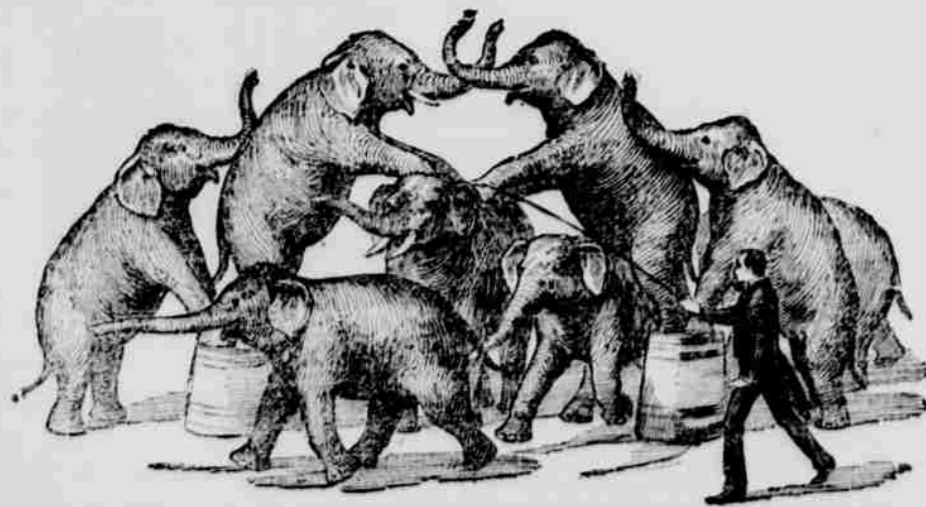

NOTICE TO WATER-CONSUMERS.

All persons using Dalles City water for irrigating purposes between the 1st day of May and the 1st day of September, will observe the following rules and regulations:

Persons will be permitted to use the water below the bluff on all even days, and above the bluff on all odd days from 6 o'clock a. m. until 8 a. m., and from 6 o'clock p. m. until 8 p. m.

The above rules must be strictly complied with, and any infraction of the above rules will subject the offender to a fine of \$1, and the water will be shut off until paid; and for a second offence double the amount.

The following charges will be made: For one full lot 50x100, \$1.50 per month. Each additional lot \$1.25; half lot 75 cts.

All persons using water in closet or toilet will see to it that the water is shut off when not in use, or water will be shut off altogether if allowed to run to waste.

For Portage Railway Lands at the Cascade Locks.

Sealed bids will be received by the board of portage commissioners of the State of Oregon until 2 o'clock p. m. May 24, 1901, and then publicly opened, for the purchase of a tract of land adjoining the United States Government Reserve above the upper entrance to the locks in the Columbia river, beginning at a point on the east boundary line of the United States Government Reserve, ninety-eight and four-tenths (98.4) feet north of the southeast corner thereof, thence northeasterly paralleling the track of the Oregon Railway and Navigation Company eleven hundred (1100) feet, being a strip eleven hundred (1100) feet long between the track of the railroad company and the Columbia river, as fully described at page 101 Book "1," Records of Deeds for Wasco County, Oregon, authority for said sale being granted by an act of the twenty-first legislative assembly, conveyance to be a bargain and sale deed.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check of the amount of twenty (20) per cent of the bid, payable to the state treasurer, to be forfeited if the balance of the purchase price is not paid within ten days after acceptance of the same.
