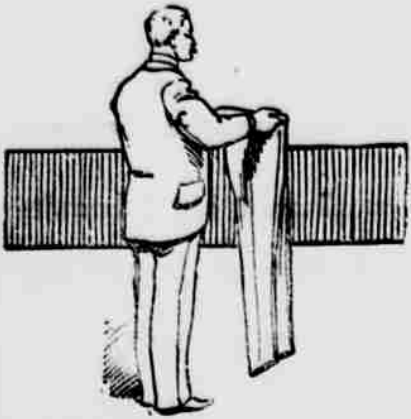

LET THE CONSTITUTION ALONE.

When our supreme court rendered its decision in the insular cases, the democrats raised a cry to the effect that the constitution should be amended so that it would always follow the flag.

As a matter of historic fact, says the Oregon Republican, the constitution has not followed the flag in territory acquired in the past, except as decreed by congress, and candor compels the statement that territory so acquired did not suffer as a result. The demand that the constitution be made to cover the Filipino, by the enactment of an amendment, is extreme. It is difficult to amend the constitution. It is not difficult for the people to make congress act and put the constitution in force.

The Filipinos will come under the constitution more quickly by act of congress than they can come under process of constitutional amendment. The constitution may need amendment, but it is doubtful that frequent or sweeping amendments of such an instrument would be wise. The more things we put into the constitution, the more we tend to make the document too rigid. The instrument must have elasticity, and that it cannot have, if an attempt is made to specify a course for every problem that may arise.

Commencing June 15th, and monthly thereafter, Genessee, Idaho, will have a sale day. The object of the day is that anyone having farm implements, cattle, horses, hogs or any article can have it offered for sale at auction without cost to the seller or buyer, the business men having subscribed enough funds to pay an auctioneer and other expenses which may be incurred. For the first day thirty head of horses, cattle, and numerous articles have been listed to sell. These sales are said to be successful in some of the Eastern states. The experiment should be watched by other sections of the Northwest.

On account of being barred by the statute of limitations, George W. Davis cannot be prosecuted for the crime of stealing \$30,000 from the state of Oregon, and hence his bondsmen cannot be made to pay. The people will foot the bill, but they will not forget, and some other climate will be healthier for Mr. Davis as a resident, says the Albany Democrat.

A report is current in a number of newspapers that if Governor Geer is renominated Ex-Governor Penoyer will take the field against him. That would be a pretty fight, sure enough, but Geer won't be renominated and Penoyer is a back number.

A law preventing the shooting of pigeons for sport passed the senate in the New York state legislature and failed to pass the house by four

votes. It should become a law in every state. Shooting birds for game is all right. They have a chance for their liberty, but deliberately taking them as they leave the trap is not an even chance and is cruel.

It now develops that the farm to which Professor Herron has retired with his blushing bride is to be only a chicken farm. This flock will understand his socialistic ideas as well as any other.—Buffalo Express.

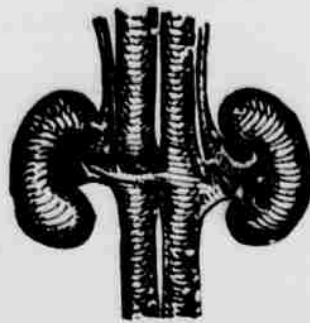

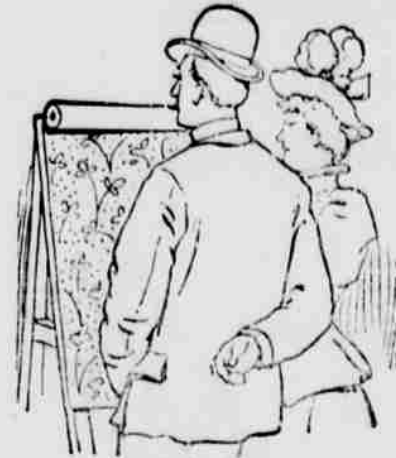
