### THE OREGON PLATFORM.

In half years, especially the key-note struck by an Ohio political convention has the unquestioned value of深入人心 with some degree of accuracy the changes, great or small, which a year's events have wrought in party judgment and party policy. Commenting on the platform recently adopted by the Republicans of that state the New York Tribune remarks that it deals freely and frankly with three important issues on which there has been a divergence in certain quarters to produce some recent and decided modifications of party opinion. Current predictions of an organized effort among Western Republicans to reverse and reduce the Dingley tariff schedule naturally find no opposition in the resolutions of the Columbus convention. On this point the platform policy says:

"The principle of protection has achieved its most signal triumph in the results of the Dingley tariff law. It has given us increased prosperity at home and a rapidly growing export trade, which are the envy of the world. The Republican tariff policy has made the farmer and laborer more prosperous than ever, and no legislation should be permitted which will impair the interests of either. Tariff schedules which will protect American labor against the low wages paid foreign labor must be maintained."

What good does such a platform leave for the much-needed statement originally made in the Oregonian a few days ago that the popular sentiment in the Middle West is vigorously demanding a general leveling of the Dingley tariff schedules? The Columbus platform makes clear to the country that any modification made in the Dingley tariff rates shall be justified and balanced by reciprocal advantages gained in export trade. Republican sentiment in the last Congress was more than sluggish in supporting the administration's efforts to extend the scope of our commercial agreements with foreign nations. The Ohio platform reassures the party's belief in the reciprocity system, and seriously urges the conclusion of new additional treaties, based on the protective principle, as will further extend our commerce."
