

THE FUTURE OF THE STRIKE

It is difficult to see what the steel strikers expect to gain by a prolonged struggle unless they are prepared at an early day to resort to force. They have exhausted whatever power they ever possessed of making the strike a political issue which would force party managers to come to their support, and low quotations for steel stocks seem not to worry the manufacturers at all. Unless they make terms they have nothing to do but see the mills start up with other labor at the convenience of the owners or lawlessly prevent others from working.

Mr. Shaffer has announced that this was not an ordinary strike, and that it was not going to be disgraced by boycotting, picketing and riots. So far he has kept his word reasonably well, but it is doubtful if he will be able much longer to control the force he has let loose in passing by the chance for settlement. He must see that a "fight to the finish" means violence. His men have been for the most part orderly in the hope of a settlement he promised and in expectation that the manufacturers would find it to their own interest to surrender.
