WILLIAM A. NEWELL.

William A. Newell, formerly governor of the territory of Washington, died at Allentown, N. J., yesterday. He was over 83 years of age. Fifty years ago Governor Newell was a man of considerable prominence in the East. Although a physician in active practice he took an interest in politics and was a member of congress from New Jersey in 1847 49 and 1865-67. He was governor of that state in 1857-59. In 1876 he was a candidate for the same office, but was defeated by General George B. McClellan. In the year 1880 he was appointed governor of Washington territory and held the position till 1884. 
