STORM IN THE SOUTH SUBSIDED

Both River and Lake Falling at New Orleans—Railroads Expected to Resume Moving Trains Last Night.

NEW ORLEANS, Aug. 16.—The big storm has practically subsided here and both the river and the lake are falling. The water has rapidly receded from the section of the city which was overflowed yesterday. Large bodies of men have gone to work to repair the damage done at the lake resorts, which bore the brunt of the storm. Little news has come thus far from the Mississippi Sound. The Louisville & Nashville Railroad is still badly crippled.

Trains have not been moved since night before last. The subsidence of the water, however, makes it probable that traffic will be resumed by tonight. A large number of business men are still bottled up on the coast and unable to get to their offices. The Northeastern road has had some trouble but the Illinois Central has aided both the Louisville & Nashville and Northeastern in handling their passenger traffic.

Captain Stevenson, of the Esther, brought up Captain Samuel J. Dunham and four members of the crew of the tug Biloxi, which capsized during the storm. The five men clung to a tree until rescued. They reported that two of the crew of the tug were missing. Captain Stevenson also reported that he saw a ship's mast sticking out of the water about nine miles from Southwest Pass. He was unable to identify the vessel and saw none of her crew. Captain Stevenson said a houseboat and some small craft had been battered to pieces in the vicinity of the Quarantine Station, but he had heard of no loss of life.

Thresher Exploded.

PENDLETON, Aug. 16.—The threshing machine of Thomas Kerr, 22 miles north of here, exploded, yesterday, completely destroying the outfit which caught fire by spontaneous combustion. The occurrence is practically without precedent. The crew was at work, when suddenly, with a loud report, the side of the machine flew outward, a mass of flames leaped into the air, enveloping the threshers and sacks, and the crew, who were compelled to hurry away to save their lives. No horses were attached, hence the machinery could not be moved from the stacks. The loss is \$2000. No insurance.

Poisoned Candy Case.

BAKER CITY, Aug. 15.—Mystery surrounds the poisoning of Ed Newton, of this city, who, it is said, was poisoned by a supposed rival for the affections of a young lady, last Sunday. While there is no doubt that the young man was poisoned, there is considerable doubt about the manner in which the poison was administered. The anonymous correspondence is quite as much a mystery as any other feature of the case. The family of the young man tried to suppress the story of the poisoning, and that too, in the face of the fact that a most foul crime was alleged to have been attempted. The police officers and representatives of the postoffice department are following up the case thoroughly, and some interesting developments are expected.

Will Pour Oil On Waters.

NEW YORK, Aug. 16.—The board of health of Montclair, N. J., has given the authorities power to purchase oil to begin the work of exterminating mosquitoes. The stagnant pools and swamp lands will be attacked first. The plan adopted by Professor Howard in South Orange of pouring the oil on the surface of the water will be adopted. This is the first time in this section that the municipal action has been taken on the mosquito problem, experiments heretofore having been carried on by private subscriptions, or by state officials.

To Prepare His Case.

WASHINGTON, August 16.—Admiral Schley, who arrived here with his wife last night, will remain until the court of inquiry which is to investigate the Santiago campaign completes its work. The interim between now and the opening of the sessions of the court, September 12th, will be devoted to the preparation of his side of the case. Today he had his first consultation with his counsel, Judge Jere Wilson, of this city; Former Representative Ravnor, of Baltimore, and Captain James Parker, of New Jersey. Admiral Schley will go over everything relative to the subject with his counsel, and place them in possession of every fact pertaining to the important events of the campaign which are in controversy. Admiral Schley declines to talk about the case.

Hot After Hood River Apples.

HOOD RIVER, Aug. 15.—The Hood River Fruitgrowers' Union recently received an order from a Chicago firm for 50,000 or 100,000 bushels of apples in bulk lots. The demand was too big for the supply, which this year will be about 90,000 boxes. Indications are that the prices will be good, and the farmers here are refusing offers of \$1.25 per box, delivered at the depot. Last year's crop netted the growers over \$1.00 a box.
