Why should not the sheriff die at his post as well as the locomotive engineer, or the priest. or the doctor or the soldier? We are setting a baleful example to our young sons, who are coming up around us, if we teach that when a prisoner is given to an officer that officer is free to desert his post of duty because there may be danger in it. It is not like Alabama or the south to tolerate such a doctrine. Let us declare our faith as to this in our fundamental law.


