It will probably be a good deal of an undertaking to secure any such reform as that outlined. Of course the only practical way of doing it is to get the several states to pass laws embodying the requirements outlined. But it would be no easy matter to get all of the states to agree to the same law. Many states, presumably those where lax divorce laws prevail, might object to any change, and if there was a single state which continued to grant divorces "while you wait," the injustice, wrongs and troubles which are said to grow out of the present divorce procedure might not be sensibly lessened. The right course is being pursued, however, and possibly in the course of time the evil of migratory divorce may be overcome .-Spokesman Review.

The Northern Pacific, Great Northern and Soo roads have decided upon a \$59 rate from the Twin Cities or from Chicago for the Episcopal congress at San Francisco October 2nd. They rejected the \$50 rate proposition which they were considering on account of the \$9 arbitrarily demanded by the Southern Pacific on all business between Portland, Or., and San Francisco.


