The census office at Washington yesterday issued a bulletin showing the division of the population of the states of North Dakota, Ohio and Oregon, and the territory of Oklahoma, in respect to sex, nativity and color. Oregon's 413,536 people are divided as follows: Males, 237,985; temales, 190,551; foreign born, 65,-748; colored, 18,954. The colored people include 10,379 Chinese, 2501 Japanese and 4951 Indians.


