The secretary of the interior has handed down a decision of great importance relative to the tenure of homestead claims. He bolds that the homesteads must actually live upon the land filed or his entry will be null and void.

The decision is given in the case in which the homestead entries of Bernard McGaraghan and William Ludton on land in Humboldt county were contested by Henry Brace and William Elsemore. 
