According to the report of the aurgeon general of the United States army, made June 30, 1900, of 3,475 cases o penetrating abdominal wounds dering the civil war, 3,031 or 87.2 per cent died. The same report is anthority for the statement that during 1898 and 1899,81 or 70 per cent of 116 cases of abdominal wounde died, and of ten cases operated upon, nine were fatal.
