Lost in Skagway Flood.

SEATTLE, Oct. 22.—If strong circumstantial evidence counts for anything it is almost certain that Benjamin Carey, of Astoria, and James Torey, of Montana, were victims of the mad torrent which flooded Skagway. It appears that the two men arrived at White Horse from down the river Thursday and started to walk to Skagway. C. Pierson was accompanying them. Pierson stated at Skagway that the trio camped on the summit Thursday night, and late Friday morning struck out for Skagway, following the railway track on account of the bad condition of the trail. Pierson left the two men warming themselves by a fire, and walked into Skagway. When he awoke next morning the flood was raging. A search was made, but no trace of the men has been found. The damage at Porcupine was far greater than that brought about by the flood in August. The swollen streams went high above the high-water mark and destruction amounting to many thousands of dollars followed in the wake of the flood.

Cruiser New York Starts For Samar.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 22.—The navy department has received the following cablegram from Rear-Admiral Rodgers: "Cavite, Oct. 22.—Secretary of the navy, Washington: Active insurrection in Samar. New York leaves today for Catbalogan with 300 marines, to return to Basey and Balangiga to co-operate with army. Nearly all naval force concentrated on Samar patrol. Services of Arethusa and Zafiro, two colliers, needed and being utilized."

Naval officers construe the dispatch to mean that the New York will go first to Catbalogan and then to Basey and Balangiga, landing detachments of marines at each point.
