

LOUGHAM UNDER ARREST.

Charged With Assault With a Dangerous Weapon on Walter Rose.

As a result of the conflict between alleged hobos, who were trying to steal a ride, and a freight train crew on the line of the O. R. & N. Co., near Clarnie station, Monday forenoon, during which Walter Rose, one of the unbidden passengers, was shot through the back. Conductor John Lougham is under arrest on the charge of assault with a dangerous weapon. Uriah Miller, of Whatcom, Wash., and William Gaubb, of Spokane, who witnessed the altercation, are in jail, detained as witnesses. Rose was operated upon and is in a precarious condition, the chances of his recovery being very slim. In the event of his death the charge against Lougham will probably be changed to murder or manslaughter. Lougham and some of the other train hands, in response to telegraphic instructions from the officials of the O. R. & N. Co., returned to Portland at 1 o'clock yesterday afternoon. They had got as far as The Dalles. Immediately upon their arrival they reported at the office of the attorneys of the railway company, and soon thereafter Lougham was served with a "John Doe" warrant for his arrest upon the charge stated. Bail in the sum of \$250 was demanded and given. The information upon which the warrant is based was sworn to by Gaubb.

Lougham refused to discuss the circumstances of the shooting beyond stating that he was obliged to defend himself and the other train hands against five hobos.

"We put them off peaceably twice," said he. "As the train pulled out the second time, the men we had put off attempted to pull the brakeman off the train, and falling in this pelted us with rocks. I believe I was justified in the shooting."

As Lougham had not yet seen his attorney when questioned in regard to the shooting, he declined to enter into the details of the trouble.

"When the proper time comes," said he, "I will state the circumstances of the case to the district attorney and make affidavit to my statements."

The bullet fired by Lougham entered Rose's back and lodged in the abdomen after puncturing the intestines seven times. In the operation the bullet was recovered and some ten inches of intestines were removed, Murphy buttons being used in making the connections.
