

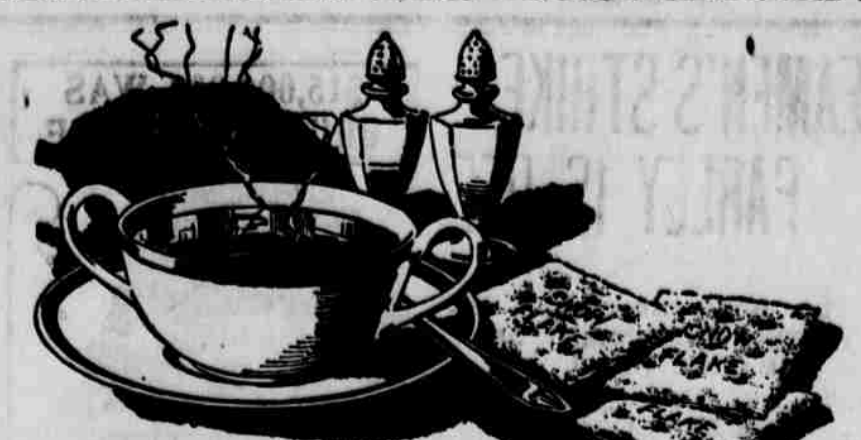
WAPINITIA NEWS
