TO LEAVE A CHILD'S HOOD. Materials—One and a half ounces of white zephyr; two ounces of blue zephyr; a pair of small bone needles; three-quarters of a yard of blue satin ribbon, two inches wide for strings.

With the white zephyr cast 120 stitches, and knit twelve rows plain. After this, narrow once at the beginning of every row, which will make the hood the proper shape. Now knit first row in purl, second row plain, third row purl, fourth row plain, fifth row purl, sixth row plain, seventh row purl, eighth row plain. This throws all the purling on the right side.

The next eight rows are the reverse of this: First row plain, second row purl, etc., which makes this stripe plain knitting on the right side. Repeat each stripe four times, (making ten stripes in all.) The head-piece will now be ninety-two rows in order; cast off and fasten the end of wool securely.

For the Cape—Cast on with the white zephyr 160 stitches, knit twelve rows plain; make a purl stripe and plain one as above; then make a row of holes, by wrapping the worsted once around the needle, and knitting two stitches together, all across the row; knit the next row plain, and cast off.

For the Border—With the blue worsted, cast on six stitches; knit first row plain. Second Row—Put the right hand needle as usual into the first stitch, but before knitting this, wrap the wool four times around the first and second fingers of left hand and right needle; knit these loops into the first stitch. Repeat to the end of the row. Third Row—Plain knitting. Fourth Row—Same as second. Repeat these two rows until you have a piece long enough for the face of the hood. Knit a similar piece for the cape; lay this trimming on the plain knitting and sew it on each side. Sew the cape to the hood, run cord and tassels through the row of holes in the former, to draw at the back of the hood, finish by sewing on the ribbon strings.
