Second, in refunding to the United States the principal amount of purchase money paid for said lands, tenements, and water privileges by the United States, and for the erection of buildings thereon...

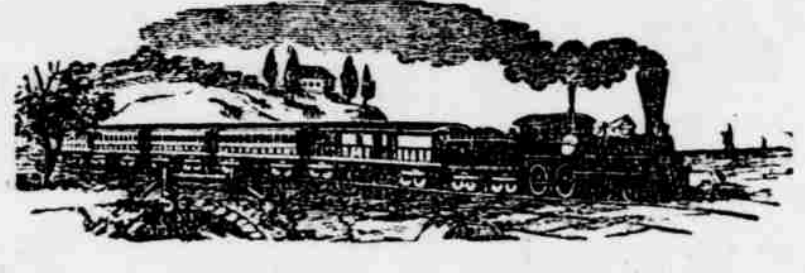
