

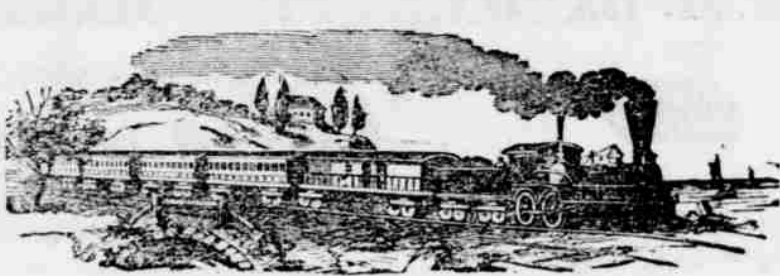
LIFE LESSONS.
