

For taking and approving any undertaking or bond, seventy-five cents.

For making and delivering a copy of any process, and a notice necessary to complete the service thereof, for each folio, twenty cents.

For summoning any panel of inrors for the circuit court, to be paid by the county, ten dollars. for summoning each panel for the county court, six dollars.

For summoning any other jury required by law, four dollars. For calling a person from the twenty cents.


