MILLER THANKS B. W. OLCOTT

Appreciates Secretary's Going Out of His Way to Pay Income Tax

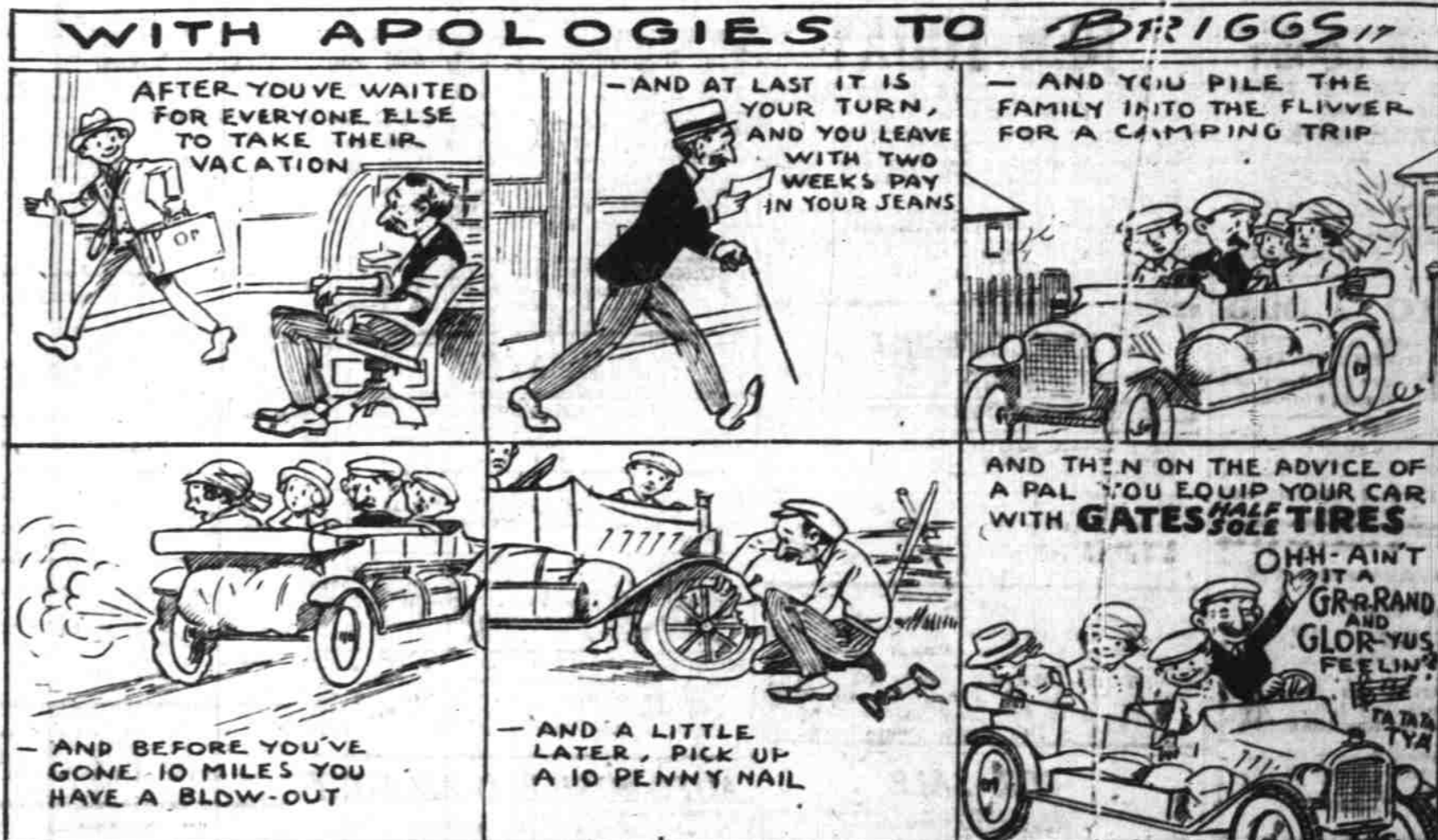
In reply to Secretary of State Olcott's request that he be allowed to pay his income tax, Milton A. Miller, collector of internal revenue, informs Mr. Olcott that this is the first instance brought to his attention of a citizen going out of his way to pay a tax which he might legally and justly avoid. "It is an example that might be emulated by other similarly situated to the direct profit of the government in the prosecution of this great war for world democracy," says Mr. Miller.

Miller's letter in part says: "I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your favor of January 23, in which you request a form for the purpose of submitting a return of your income, with the intention of paying income tax thereon, despite the fact that the law specifically exempts so much of your income as is derived from the state of Oregon.

"Forms for reporting incomes in excess of \$3,000 have not yet been received from Washington, but I have made a note to see that you are supplied as soon as they arrive, which should be within the next few days.

"In passing, I cannot refrain from congratulating you upon your very laudable desire to help the government in these stressful times by waiving the exemption to which your official position entitles you; and as the representative of Uncle Sam in these matters I shall be glad to accept your return and payment of tax and transmit it to the department in due course, where final action must, of course, be taken.

"It is apparent that there is a widespread spirit of helpfulness throughout the country in the matter of seeing that there shall be no laggards so far as the payment of income tax is concerned, but your of-

PORTLAND, Jan. 26.—Special rates will be granted by the railroads to the coming big Portland Automobile, Truck and Tractor Show, which will be held in the new city auditorium from February 7 to 13, inclusive.

The war has emphasized the economic importance of the automobile as never before. One of the main purposes of the automobile show will be to demonstrate the many ways in which the passenger automobile, the truck and the farm tractor can help business and industry and there by add to the war resources of the nation.

All the latest passenger car models will be shown, but the truck and the farm tractor, particularly, will save a place of honor at the

show. The farm tractor has added tremendously to the agricultural efficiency of France and Great Britain.

In fact, farm tractors have helped so greatly to defeat the German submarine campaign by making possible the cultivation of increased acreage for food production, that the French and British governments have placed huge orders in this country for still more of them.

The United States government is encouraging the use of tractors and trucks to offset the growing shortage of manpower and horses and to increase food production and business efficiency. Added to this is the fact that they are cheaper to operate than horses doing only a small part of the work.

A large attendance from outside points is expected during the Automobile Show Week. Special arrangements are being made for the reception of dealers and other visitors from outside of Portland.

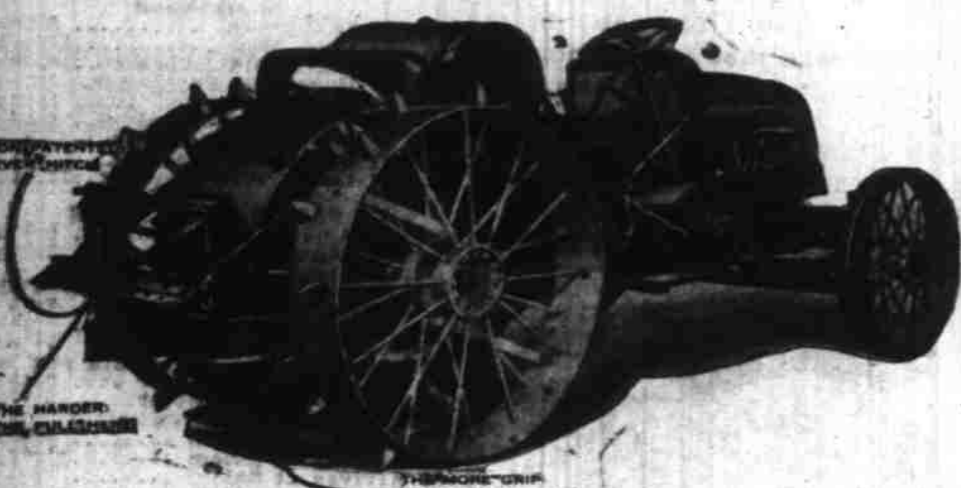
Stocker Makes Successful Appeal to Pratum People

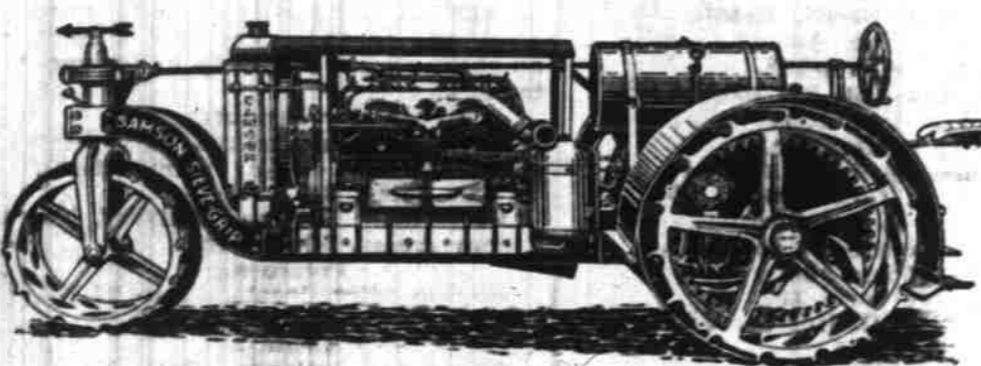
