### Exchange

NEW YORK, March 21 .- Another brisk inquiry for liberty bonds was the distinguishing feature of today's session of the stock exchange. Deal-Post ings in stocks diminished steadily until the final hour when moderate activity set in under lead of indus-

These shares were favored because of an advance in crude oil prices and intimations from Washington that the new schedule for steel and MODERN NEW 5 ROOM BUNGALOW iron would in all probability eliminate existing inequalities.

Texas company was foremost among the oils at an extreme gain of five points and United States Steel was roused out of its previous torpor, gaining almost a point on relatively heavy action.

Other substantial gains were conined to such specialties as American Car, inactive equipments and Industrial Alcohol, Distillers Securities. and Malting preferred at advances of one to two points.

Early pressure upon rails, motors and tobaccos was partly overcome in the general rally of the close but some gains, notably that of Union Pacific, proved only temporary. Sales amounted to 260,000 shares.

Official seizure of Holland's ships nd the Teutonic bombardment on the western front were among the deterrent developments of the forenoon

Liberty issues again constituted he sole features of the bond market, second 4s gaining almost 1 per ent but reacting sharply later. Sales, par value, aggregated \$6,-650,000.

United States bonds, old issues, unchanged on call.
