ALL QUARTERS SHOW STRENGTH
Stock Exchange Unusually Busy—Coppers and Rails Heavy

NEW YORK, May 11.—The stock market ended an extremely busy week as it began, on a wave of bullish enthusiasm which carried numerous special issues to highest levels of the year.
There were some offsetting features, such as the relative heaviness of rails and coppers, but these were more than overbalanced by the strength in all other quarters.
United States Steel was again in the forefront, advancing from its low price of 107 1/2 to 109 3/4, within a small fraction of its current maximum.
Oils, sugars, tobacco and shipments, the latter represented by Marine preferred were the other conspicuously strong features.
Backwardness of rails and metals resulted from disappointment at the failure of the Washington authorities to announce higher transportation rates. Sales amounted to 550,000 shares.
The new liberty 4 1/2 per cent bonds continued to fall, declining from 97 1/2 of the old of 98.48 to 95.20. Of the older liberty issues, the first 4 1/2 per cent issue was the year's low at 95.64. The second 4's also showing heaviness. Total bond sales, par value, aggregated about \$3,750,000.
An actual loss increase of about \$82,000,000 and an expansion of more than \$65,000,000 in excess reserves were the noteworthy features of the weekly bank statement.

ANNOUNCEMENT DEPRESSES CORN
Market Closes Unsettled—Government Edicts Curb High Cereal Prices

CHICAGO, May 11.—Announcement by the food administration that flour substitutes must sell 10 cents below wheat cost had a depressing influence today on the corn market. Largely as a result corn closed unsettled, 2 1/2 cent net lower to 1 1/2 cent advance with May \$1.27 and July \$1.42 1/2 @ 1/4. Oats lost 1/4 to 2 cents and provisions 32 to 60 cents.
