### CARDS FOR LIBERTY GARDEN.

The liberty garden card may soon be as common and as welcome a sight as the food conservation card now is. The new card would be displayed on premises whose owners or occupants are cultivating a supervised liberty garden.

The subject of the supervision of the small war garden is receiving the attention of the United States department of agriculture and the council of national defense, and to the end that waste of time, material, and effort on the part of amateur gardeners may be avoided. It is planned that expert advice will be made available to all liberty gardeners who sign the garden pledge.

"As a possible means of stimulating interest in 'directed' gardens," says the woman's committee of the council of national defense, "we suggest the use of the pledge and record cards that have been drawn up by garden specialists in the United States department of agriculture. Persons signing the pledge card will be entitled to display on their premises a liberty garden card. The importance of record cards is twofold: First, the keeping of such a record tends to hold the individual gardener to book and gives him a better understanding of the strong and weak points of his garden methods. Second, it makes possible an intelligent survey of the results of the season's work."

### FEAR OF DELAY ADVANCES CORN

Unsettled cooler weather adverse to planting discourages selling

### CHICAGO, May 20.

Fears of dangerous delays to planting did a good deal today to advance the value of corn. Prices closed strong at the same as Saturday's finish to 2 1/2c higher, with May 1.27 1/2 to % and July 1.42 1/2 to %. Oats gained 1 1/2 and 1 1/2 to 2 1/2c net. In provisions the outcome varied from 10c decline to 30c advance.

Unsettled cooler weather adverse to rapid planting tended decidedly to discourage selling of corn. Bullish sentiment was further augmented by the percentage of damaged corn in current arrivals and by doubts therefore as to whether a liberal amount of contract grade would be available for June and July delivery.

Gossip of a revival of export inquiry helped to lift the oats market.

Big exports of meats gave strength to provisions and so, too, did higher quotations on hogs. The con-
