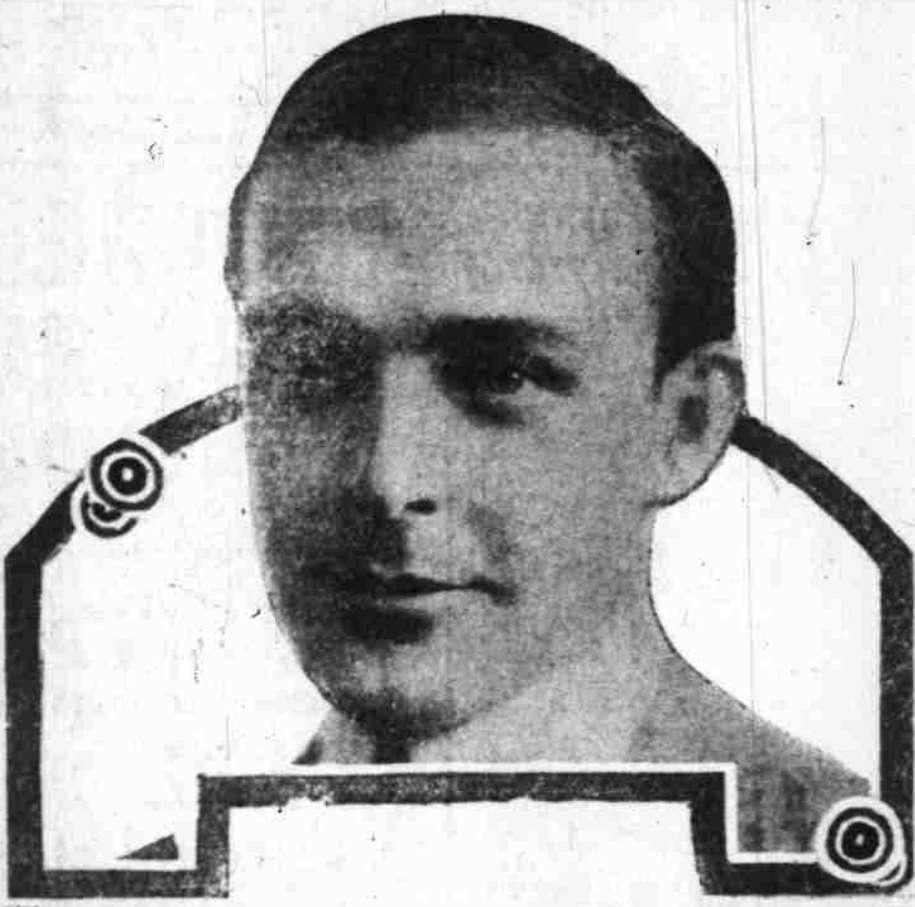

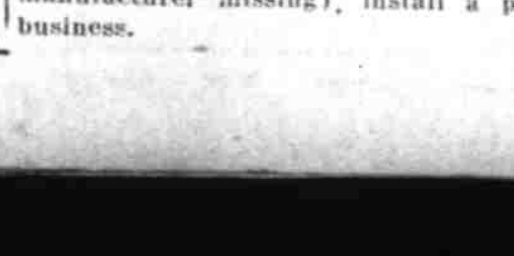
Reclamation Fund Placed at \$100,000 at Olympia
