WASHINGTON, March 13.—Although operating expenses of the principal railroads of the country showed a decrease in January, gross and net operating revenues continued to decline, the net revenue, after deduction of taxes, falling about \$54,000,000 short of the government's average monthly rental obligation of approximately \$75,000,000.

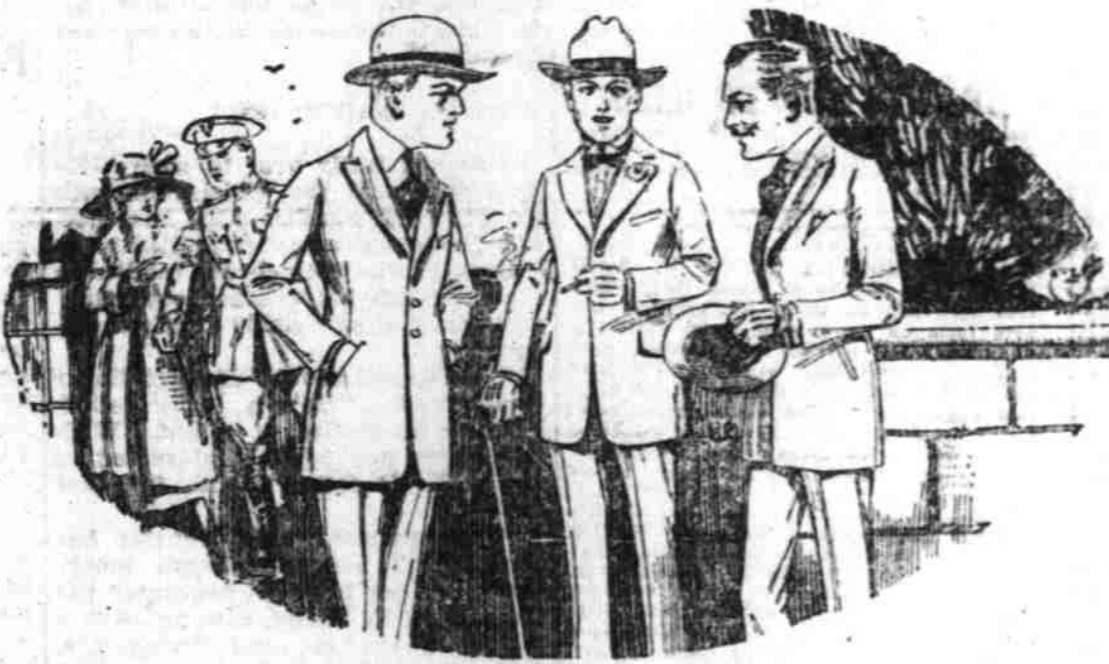
