WET WEATHER RAISES PRICES

Eagerness to Realize on Holdings Weakens Corn Despite Influence of Rain

CHICAGO, April 14.—Eagerness to realize on holdings weakened the corn market today after May delivery influenced by wet weather had reached the highest price level this season. The close was heavy, 3/4 to 1 1/2 net lower, with May 1.52 1/2 to 1.58 1/2 and July 1.52 1/2 to 1.52 1/2. Oats finished 3/4 to 1c down.

In provisions the outcome ranged from fifteen decline to 45 advance. Prospects that the crop movement would be latered with by widespread rains gave an advantage at the outset but the corn, in better condition, however, lasted until a new top price for the season had been established in the May option. Oats reflected the weakness of corn.

Provisions like corn ran up to high price levels, and then reacted sharply on profit taking.
