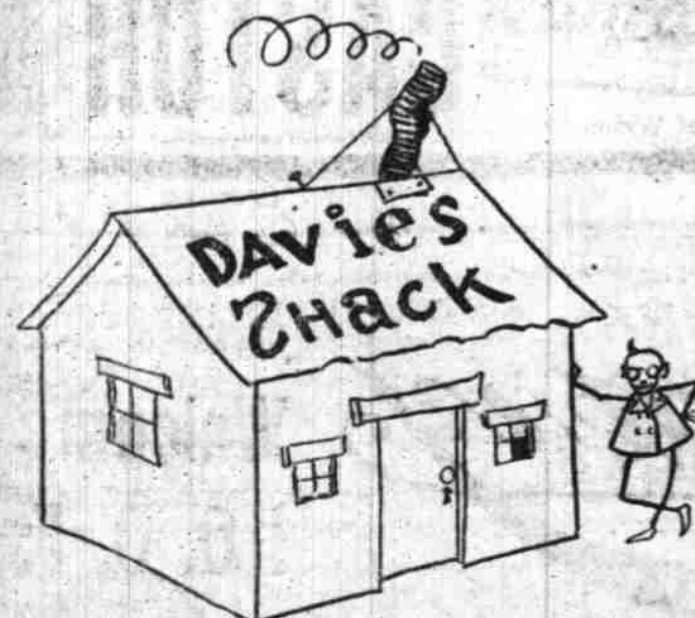

## I. O. O. F. HEADS SMASH RECORDS

Effective Work Is Done by  
W. F. Walker and Mrs. Jeanie F. Burke

The little village of Springfield, in Lane county, is proud of the fact that the head of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows in Oregon, the man who will preside at the session of the Grand lodge, when the 100th anniversary of the order is celebrated at Salem this week, is one of its own prominent citizens—W. F. Walker, who was elected to the high position he occupies at the Seaside session of the Grand lodge, just one year ago. Walker has completed his report to the Grand lodge and it shows that he has probably made a record in that he and his official staff have visited practically every subordinate lodge in the jurisdiction during the year just closing. Walker is constantly at work up-building the organization which has so highly honored him. In accordance with custom he is expected to be elected a representative from the Grand lodge of Oregon to the Sovereign Grand lodge at next week's session.

The order throughout the state shows a considerable gain despite the war and the influenza epidemic which prevented most of the lodges of the state from holding business sessions for several months. Two new lodges were organized by him during the year, each with a large charter.
