CATALINA AUTO RECORDS SET

Mitchell "Victory Six" Makes Climb from Avalon to Summit in Eight Minutes

In a series of three stunt tests performed on Santa Catalina Island last week with the Mitchell Victory Six, according to official timers, broke all existing records for the island on very severe runs.

The first record smashing for the day was done in making the climb from Avalon to the summit of the island in eight minutes flat.

The car went up the steep Descanso canyon grade, 1400 feet in four miles on high averaging thirty miles an hour for the hill test.

Returning to Avalon the same car traveled from there to Middle ranch, a distance of 11 miles, over rough roads in 27 minutes.

The best exhibition of the day was made on the third and final test when the Mitchell went from Avalon to the isthmus in 58 minutes and 36 seconds.

This route consists of 28 miles of dangerous narrow one-way mountain grades. The normal running time for this trip is two hours and the Mitchell is the first car to accomplish the feat in less than 60 minutes.

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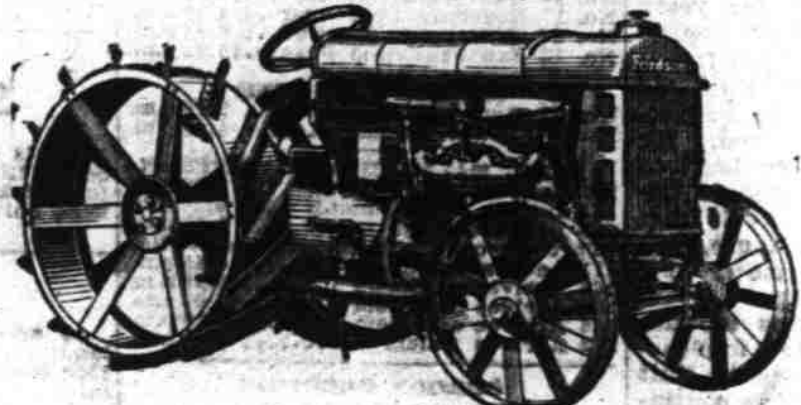
