One of the yeomen went home in a very thoughtful frame of mind, and next drill day came on parade with three silver medals pinned on his many chest. Seeing them glittering in the sunshine, the officer approached the man. "I didn't know that you had been in the wars," he said. "No, I haven't," was the reply. "Well, how about the medals?
