Kidnapings have been so frequent recently in New York and vicinity that the New York Police Bureau of Missing Persons has had many requests from anxious mothers to have their children "foot-printed." Inspector Joseph Faurot was the originator of the new scheme, which he declares is a much more exact way than finger-printing to establish identity. It has been adopted by the police of Chicago and other western cities. In New York "foot-printing" has been introduced into maternity hospitals to insure against the possibility of mothers not getting their own babies when they leave the institutions.
