National Forests of Oregon and Washington to be Re-planted This Spring  
More than 1500 acres of burned-over land on the national forests of Oregon and Washington will be replanted with trees this spring according to an announcement by District Forester George H. Cecil. This includes 540 acres of the Cispus burn, in the Rainier national forest, and 714 acres of the Selduck burn, near Lake Crescent, in the Olympic forest in Washington; 258 acres on the Breitenbush water-

shed of the Santiam forest and 35 acres in the vicinity of Rustler park, on the Crater forest in Oregon.  
With the exception of 40,000 yellow pine seedlings from Page Creek nursery, in the Siskiyou national forest, which will be used on the Rustler peak area, all the planting stock will come from the Wind River nursery, near Carson, Wash., in the Columbia national forest, and will consist chiefly of Douglas fir, A little noble fir, silver fir and western white pine will be used on the Breitenbush project.  
Shipping of the more than a million baby trees to various planting sites began this week at the Wind River nursery.
