Business in Schulderman's Office Grows During Recent Months H. J. Schulderman, state corpor-

ation commissioner, estimates that between \$250,000 and \$300,000 will. be collected by the corporation department during the months of June, July and August, covering the payment of license fees by corporations operating in the state. Mr. Schulderman yesterday sent out letters to all corporations with annual report blanks and notices regarding license payments. About 10,000 letters

were sent out. Mr. Schulderman prepared a statement showing the growth of the corporation department during the last nine months as compared with the same period last year. A new record is set in the number of articles received and filed and in the increase in fees.

The following figures are shown:

Number of articles of incorpor-

ation filed from July 1, 1918, to March 31, 1919, 383. Number of articles filed from July 1, 1919, to March 31, 1920, 778, showing a gain of 393, or over 100 per cent. Amount of fees collected from July 1. 1918, to March 31, 1919, \$112,493.62. Amount of fees collected from July 1, 1919, to March 31, 1920, \$178,114.80, a net gain of \$65,620.98, a gain of over 50


