TAX IS INVALID COURT OPINION

School District No. 24 Not to Receive Funds in Hands of Superintendent.

The Oregon supreme court, in an opinion written by Justice Johns and handed down here yesterday dismissed the action brought by School District No. 24, Marion county, to compel W. M. Smith, school superintendent of Marion county to turn over to that district certain funds levied for school purposes. It was held in the opinion that the original tax levy for school purposes exceeded the six per cent limitation, and had been so decreed by the Marion county circuit court in an opinion given some time ago. As a result of this decision Justice Johns declared that County Superintendent Smith had no control over funds exceeding the six per cent limitation and could not be compelled to pay over money so raised to the various school districts of the county. 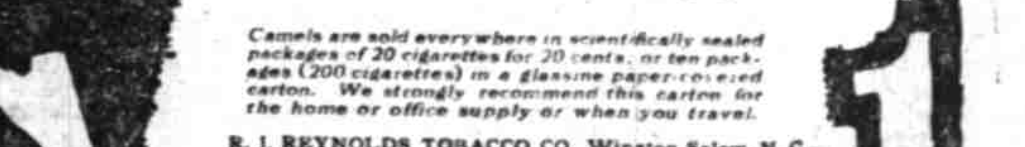
