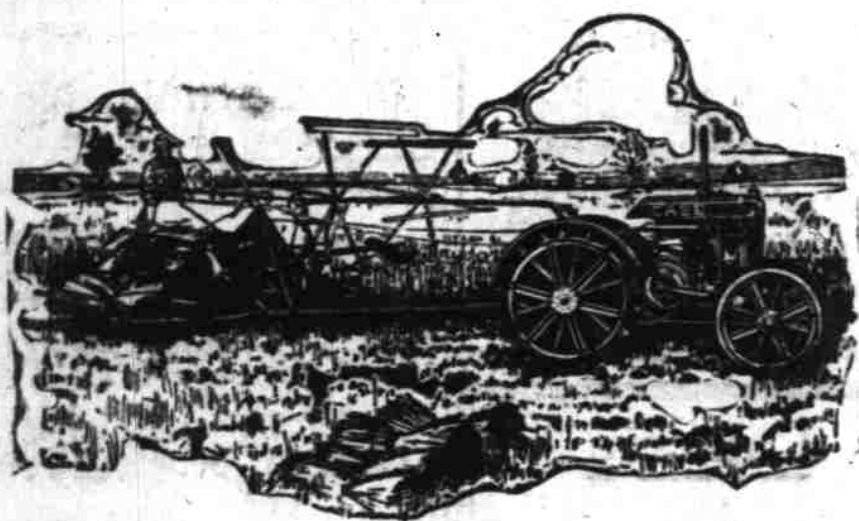

**63 SUITS HEARD
IN LOCAL COURT**

**Marion County Had Average
Business During Past 3
Months is Report.**

Marion county had an average business during the past three months ending June 30, according to the report of Clyde Ellis, deputy county clerk, submitted to the secretary of state as required under the provisions of chapter 35 general laws of Oregon 1917.

The quarterly report made on March 30 showed more judicial business transacted at the county clerk's office and by the circuit court of Marion than the last quarter.

The expense incurred in trials, hearings and suits struck a medium as compared with other quarterly reports. The cost of petit jury in the circuit for the quarter ending June 30 was \$985.80, the cost of the grand jury in the circuit court \$33, and cost for bailiff services in the circuit court was \$159. Witnesses obtained

for criminal cases that were tried in the circuit court entailed an expense of \$419.80.

Sixty-three cases consisting of divorces, criminal actions, civil cases, equity suits, contested equity suits, contested divorce suits, non-contested divorce suits, were heard in the circuit court. Only 15 cases require the services of jurymen. One criminal case was heard and tried by jury. Eleven cases in civil court were tried by jury.

Eighty-eight cases were filed in the county clerk's office. Forty of these were actions filed in circuit court. 23 equity suits other than divorce cases were filed for hearing. Incidentally during the last 12 days of June an average of a divorce a day was filed establishing a record for the year for the length of time.

A large number of estates were filed numbering 48, two will contests and nine guardianships were filed at the county clerk's office. Only one adoption is on record for the quarter ending June 30.
