#### More Road Improvements Planned by Commission

Sealed blds for the construction of several culverts and the improvement of considerable roads in Douglas. Lane, Polk and Sherman countles, will be opened at a meeting of the state highway commission to be held in Portland on July 20, according to announcement made here. The proposed improvements fol

/Douglas county-Reinforced con-rete culverts between Comstock and Lane county line, 105 cubic yards of concrete, 9000 pounds of metal reinforcement, 20 'lineal feet of corrugated iron pipe and 84 lineal feet of concrete pipe. section. Lane county-Goldson

1.2 miles grading. Polk county-Yamhill county line -Butler's store, McMinnville-Tilla-mook highway, 7.6 miles grading and rocking.

Sherman county-Columbia river highway, 14.8 miles graveling. In the event bids for these improvements are satisfactory, actual building operations probably will start late in the present month.
