PALESTINE IN JEWISH HANDS

Can Develop Land and Reap Harvests But Can Never Sell It.

NEW YORK, July 17.—While the Jewish people will be permitted to develop and reap the harvest from land purchased in Palestine by the Jewish National fund and also be privileged to leave it to their children, they can never sell it. This is in accordance with the plan of the fund to nationalize the land in Palestine and eliminate land speculation as announced here by Dr. Haer Epstein, the fund's special commissioner, who has just arrived from England.

The fund, he said, will spend \$1,250,000 during the next year for the purchase of barren land which must be reclaimed and made fit for settlement by Jewish renters.

More than 7,000,000 French francs Dr. Epstein added, have already been spent in buying and cultivating 6000 acres of what now is fertile Palestine land and in developing six agricultural colonies and a dozen individual farms.

"The fund not only has purchased land for farming," he said, "but it has made extensive purchases in Jerusalem, Tiberias, Haifa, Jaffa, Safed and the other principal cities of Palestine. This city land is used exclusively for public buildings."

While they would be glad to put the ban on both, they realize that reforms so radical could not be safely undertaken at this time. They will also tell you that they must have the income from these sources during the present lapse in business affairs.

The plain truth is Mexico is down and out. She needs help from some source outside of her domain and must have it before she can regain her former standing among the nations of the world.

Her people are impoverished but not hopeless. The Mexicans need an American chance. They are a resourceful people. For centuries they have been the victims of oppression and misrule. Yet under the most grinding tyranny they have not only survived but actually increased in number.

Faith Placed in Obregon. Much hope is now being entertained for renewed prosperity and orderly development in Mexico and the restoration of peace among her unfortunate people. General Obregon is now recognized as the strong man in Mexican affairs. All classes are looking to him for guidance.

Both Obregon and Huerta, the provisional president, have publicly declared themselves to be in favor of

a liberal and progressive policy in the management of both national and international affairs. They assure foreign investors that each will get a square deal as a stimulus to develop Mexico's vast natural resources. These men know there is no other way out of the present stagnation. That they will exert every effort to retrieve Mexico's lost prestige and restore peace and prosperity among her people is the belief of a good many well informed people residing on both sides of the border.

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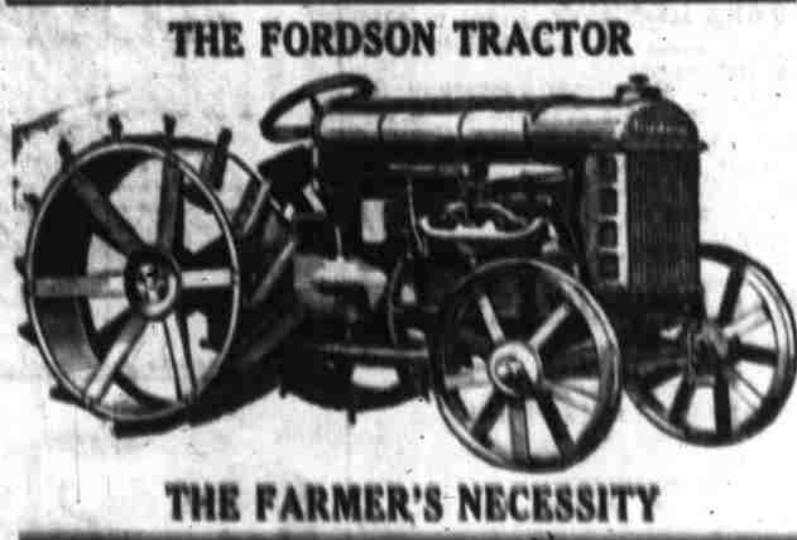
