HIGHER RATES IN STATE ARE DUE AUG. 26

Service Commission Announces They Come With General Increase

ALL STATES AGREED

Tentative Pact Adopted at Seattle Is Followed in Board's Policy

Increased intrastate freight rates will become effective in Oregon August 26, simultaneous with the general rate increases on interstate shipments approved by the interstate commerce commission. This announcement was made Saturday by the public service commission. The action of the Oregon commission is pursuant to a tentative agreement made in a conference at Seattle to which the commissions of Oregon, Washington and Idaho were parties. Also it is in accord with advice of the interstate commerce commission that the increased rates be made effective as early as possible.

Opinion followed. "This commission," says the statement of Saturday, "after investigation and conference upon the subject held in the city of Portland at which representatives of the state, important shippers and carriers were present, believes it advisable to follow the consensus of opinion as expressed at that time, namely, that the interests of all concerned will be best conserved by following the action taken by the interstate commerce commission, that is, permitting the tariffs to become effective in the regular way as provided in the act and that any inequalities or irregularities be later adjusted.

Action is consistent. "The action proposed by the Oregon commission is in line with that followed by most of the state commissions throughout the United States and in accord with the urgent suggestion made by the three state commissioners who sat with the interstate commerce commission at the hearing of the recent rate case. The public service commission, in pursuing this course, wishes it clearly understood that our action does not in any way establish the reasonableness of the rates filed or preclude a shipper from bringing action or prevent this commission from attacking any rate so filed."

First Aid Station Is Plan for Paper Mill

Will T. Kirk, of the state industrial accident commission, is in Oregon City yesterday to complete plans for the establishment of a first aid station in the plant of the Crown-Willamette Paper company. It will be the first aid station of this character established in the state and if it works out successfully the system will be extended to other plants. A trained nurse will be in charge of the station. All workmen injured in the mill will be taken immediately to the station. If the injuries are minor they will have the care of the nurse. If serious a physician will be summoned.
