

### NEW FORESTRY SAVING PLAN IS OUTLINED

State Board Likely to Take Action at Next Meeting in Portland

**MUST GET PROTECTION**  
Appropriation of \$1,000,000 Yearly from Government Contemplated

An entirely new state forest policy, which will coincide and with and be in co-operation with a new national policy advocated by Col. W. B. Greeley, national forester, may grow out of the next meeting of the state board of forestry, to be held in Portland early next month.

The plan contemplates a greatly increased amount of money to be made available for Oregon as well as other timber states for protection against fire, the primary object being to allow logged over and burned over areas, once permanently protected from fire, to become reforested through natural processes.

**Weeks Fund Too Small**  
The new plan is one that F. A. Elliott, Oregon state forester, has had in mind for several years, and now that a similar plan has been involved by federal authorities indications are that results will be obtained.

Through the Weeks fund law, under which the government now co-operates with 25 states in fire patrol work in the forests, the entire amount distributed to the states is only \$100,000 a year and Oregon gets only \$7500. Under the new plan federal forest authorities will attempt to have congress appropriate \$1,000,000 for distribution, which would make \$50,000 a year available in Oregon provided the state legislature appropriated \$100,000 covering a biennium to match the federal money.

"The state board of forestry has been requested by federal authorities to act as a committee to formulate a state policy," said State Forester Elliott today. "In turn the state board has asked a representative of the Western Pine Manufacturing association and a representative of the Columbia River Loggers association to join with the state board in working out the policy."

**Protection is Basis**  
Colonel Greeley, national forester, believes that about 80 per cent of the whole forestry requirement in the country is fire protection. This forms a basis for the proposed new policy. The primary effort will be to keep fire out of the logged over and burned over areas so they may reforest themselves. Startling figures have come to hand, it is said, relative to the length of time the standing timber of the United States will last if better protection is not afforded, and the number of years is not many.

Under the new plan it is proposed eventually to reclassify the lands suitable for cultivation would not be reforested but a campaign of reforestation would be waged aggressively relative to lands not fit for cultivation.
