

LEAGUE WILL ENFORCE LAW

Anti-Saloon Organization May Seek \$50,000 Appropriation for Governor

A formidable law enforcement department is slated for organization with the Oregon anti-saloon league, and included in its proposed program may be an effort to cause the legislature to appropriate \$50,000 for law enforcement expenditures of the governor's office alone.

E. A. Baker, president of the Anti-Saloon league, and W. J. Herwig, its secretary, were here yesterday in conference with Governor Olcott and told of the plans for a strong law enforcement department. Incidentally, they asked the governor how he would like an appropriation of \$50,000 for law enforcement work.

Governor Dubious. The governor replied that he could make good use of the money but that because of the difficulty which will be met by the legislature in making necessary appropriations under the 6 per cent constitutional amendment he believed it very doubtful whether the legislature would consider a law enforcement appropriation of that amount.

Old stock and shipped in quantities of liquor are causing comparatively little trouble in enforcement of the prohibition law, according to Mr. Herwig. Trouble is being made, however, by the hidden stills and the home brew experts, and this phase of law enforcement, Mr. Herwig believes, will continue to bother police authorities for some years.

State Law Not Modified. Mr. Baker, who is an attorney, said the decree of Judge Wolvertson of the federal court in Portland, holding that premises cannot be searched under the federal law on authority of "John Doe" warrants, will not affect operations under the state law. Under the Volstead act Judge Wolvertson held that warrants must be based on proper information and contain the actual names of persons whose property is to be searched.

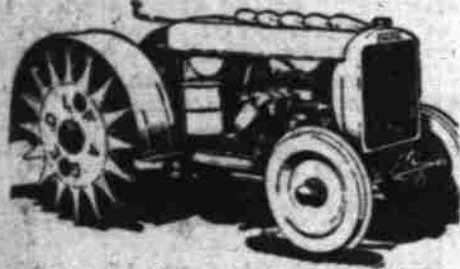

The Hauden Island Improvement company filed a resolution showing a decrease in capitalization from \$1,000,000 to \$500,000. Resolutions of dissolution were filed by the Douglas Creditor's corporation of Roseburg.
