# Water Starts Fire in Recent Department Test

Boston, Jan. 7 .- The phenomenon of water starting a fire is one that may occur in hose lines that are tested under certain conditions, but would never be encountered in practical fire department work, according to the conclusions of an expert who has made tests with different engines and different types of hose as a result of the Boston fire department report of the burning of a hose with no flame nearby.



The vibration was found to be produced largely by a variance in the pressures on the pump side of the throttle gate and the hose side due to chocking down of the opening.

Under such conditions the type of pump and the make of hose are not factors in the result. Engineer Caldwell found. He summarized his conclusions with the Drilling for oil on Newman statement that "the possibility of burning hose, while interesting, because of its peculiar nature, is a matter which does not warrant any change in the design of either pumping equipment or hose as the conditions under which it is produced would never be encountered in practical fire department work."
